

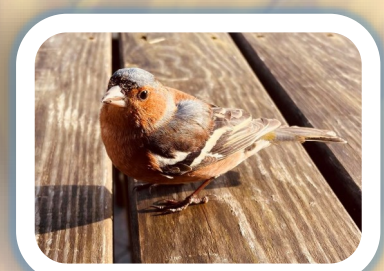
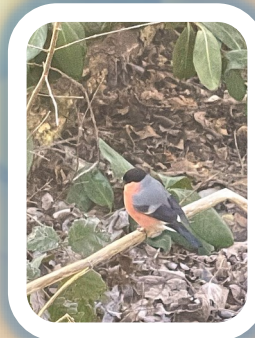

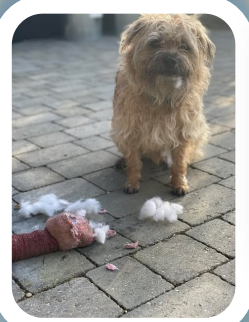

Milo is still unsure of why this needs to happen but Bramble is adamant that this **MUST** happen with anything that resembles a toy or ball.

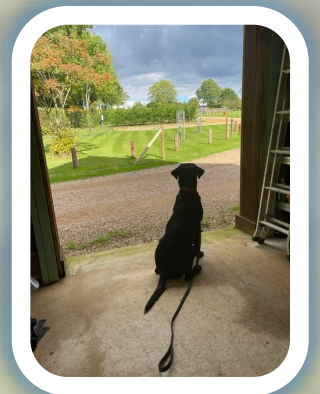


Checking the site activity (this can easily be mistaken as staring aimlessly but in fact there is much skill in this aspect of the role)

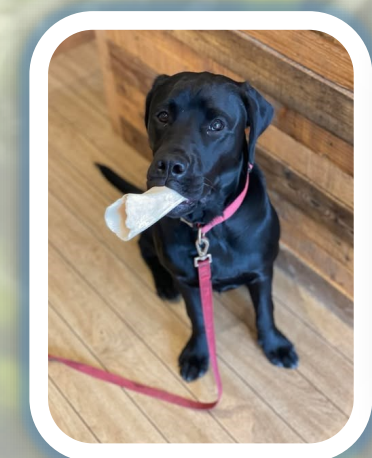
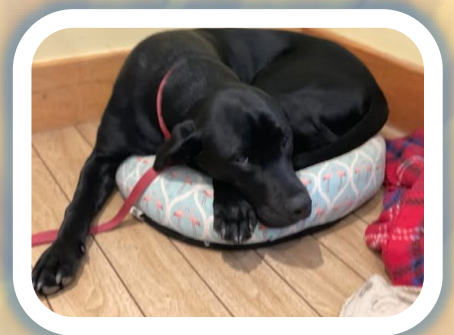
